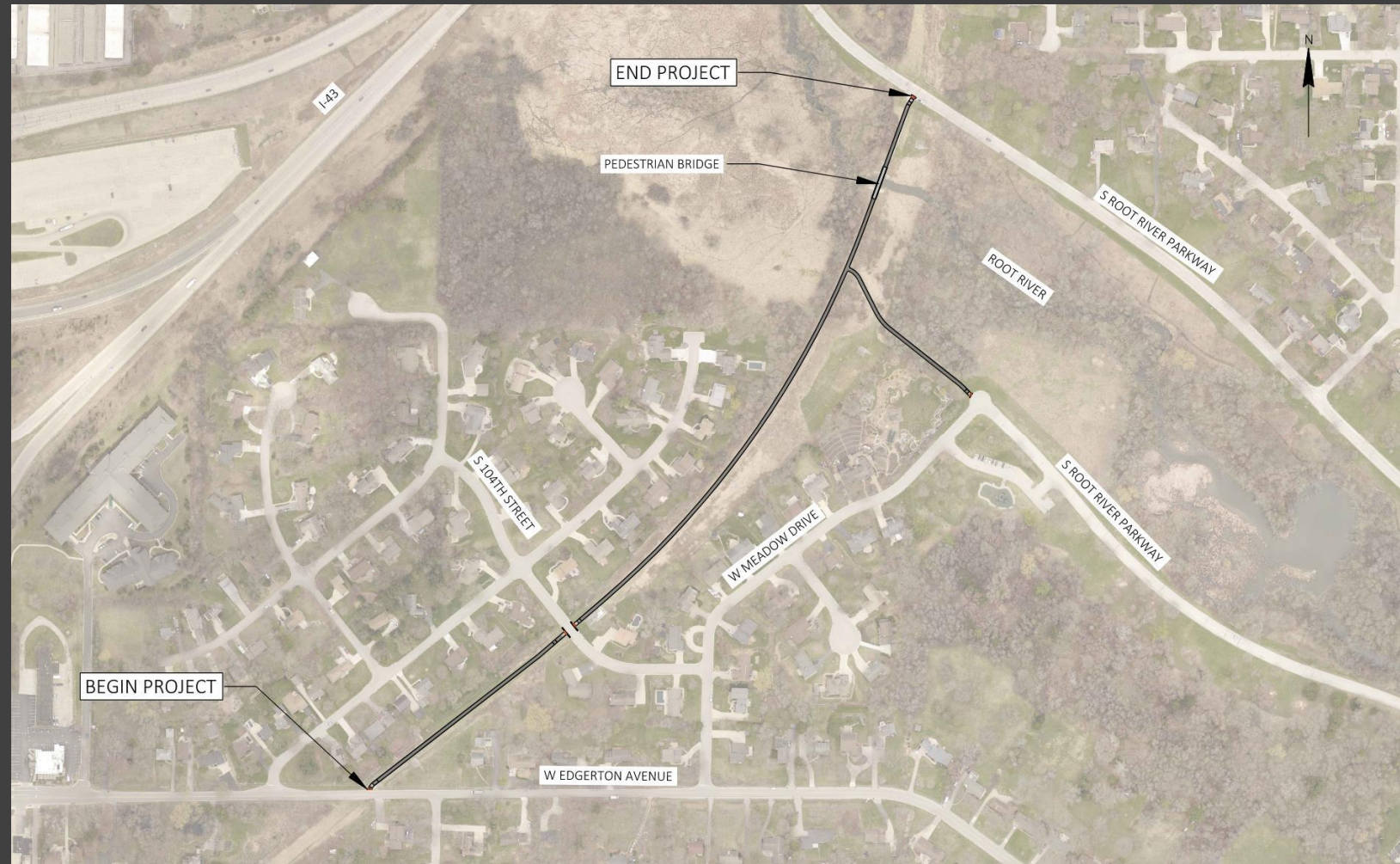

Project Overview

- 0.5-mile paved trail
- Beginning at Edgerton Ave traveling northeast to the Root River Parkway and Oak Leaf Trail
- Pedestrian bridge over the Root River
- Side connection to Meadow Dr
- Within We Energies corridor and Milwaukee County parkland
- WisDOT grant for funding
- Total anticipated cost = \$1.3 million



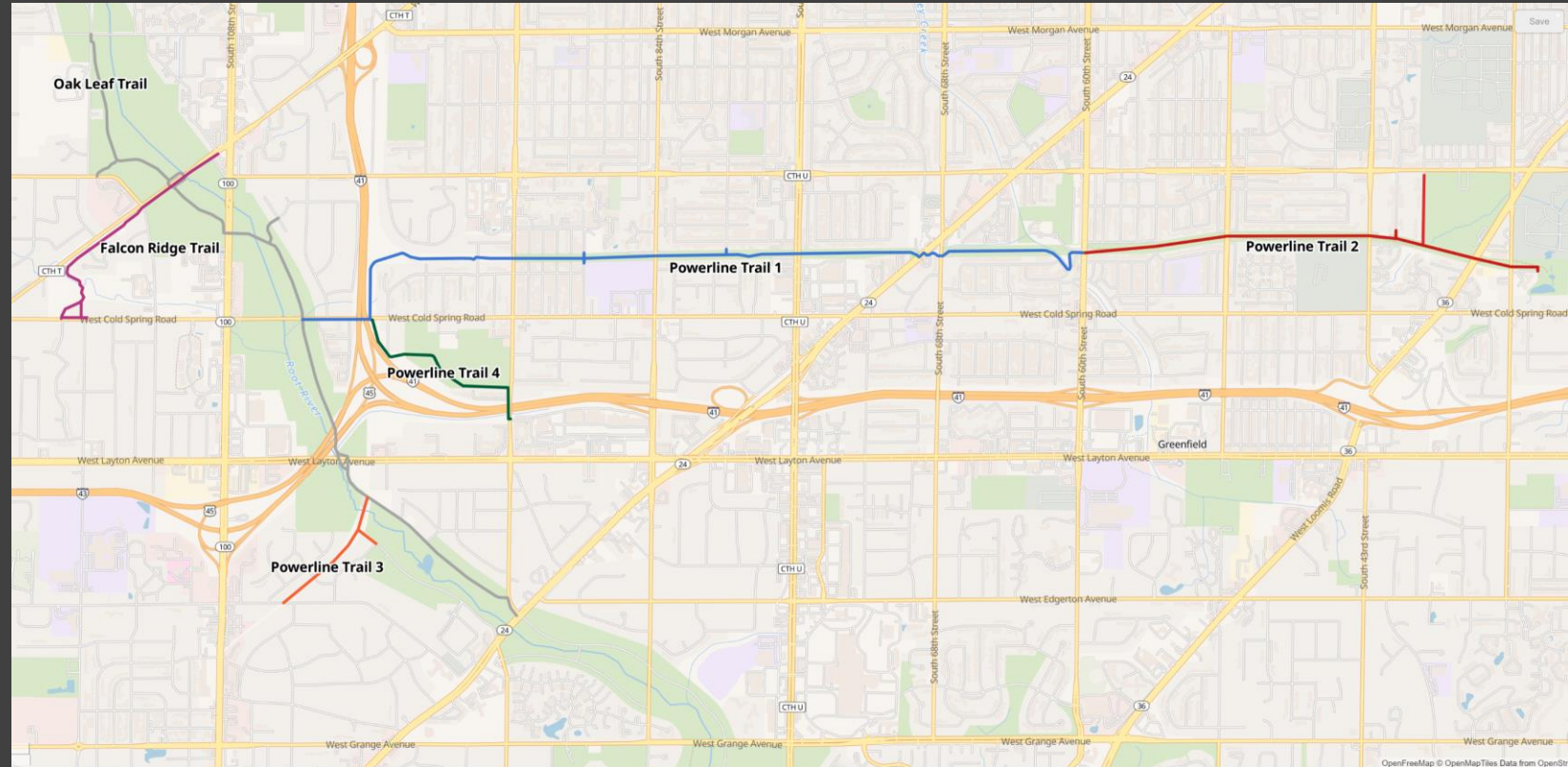


Project Timeline

- **Design Begins: January 2024**
- 30% Design: September 2024
- Public Involvement Meeting: October 2024
- Environmental Document: November 2024
- 60% Design: January 2025
- 90% Design: May 2025
- Final Design: August 2025
- Project Bid: Late 2025
- **Construction: 2026**

Path Connectivity

- Connects directly to the Oak Leaf Trail on the Root River Parkway.
- The Oak Leaf Trail connects to other regional trails including the Powerline Trail Phases 1 and 2, the Hank Aaron Trail and the New Berlin Trail.
- The Powerline Trail Phases 1 and 2 are the first constructed phases of a east-west trail link to Lake Michigan as part of the Rails to Trails designated Route of the Badger.



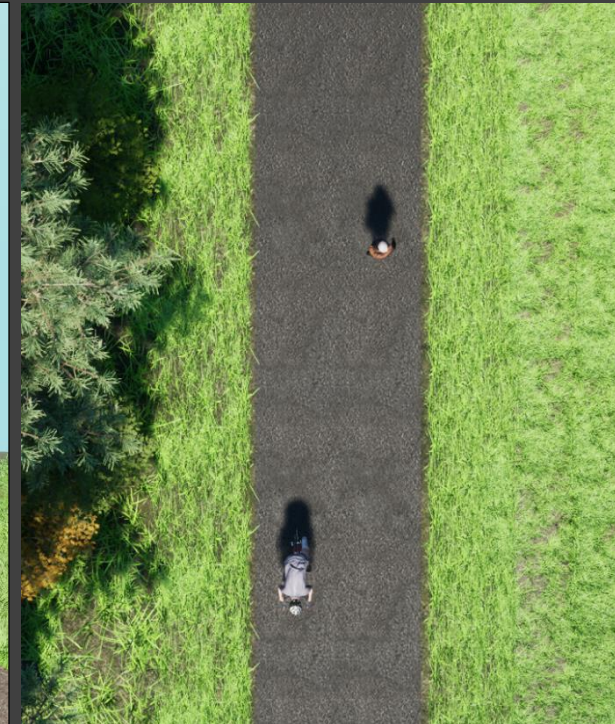
Project Funding

- Total Project Cost: \$1.3 million
- WisDOT Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality (CMAQ) Grant: \$998,000
- Local funds for remainder



Design Details

- 10' wide asphalt trail generally centered within the narrowest part of the We Energies corridor
- 10' wide asphalt trail side connection to Meadow Dr crosses Milwaukee County parkland
- Road intersections improved with curb ramps, detectable warning fields, signage & crosswalks
- Pedestrian bridge over the Root River



We Energies Corridor: Basics

- Trail will generally travel in the center of the We Energies utility corridor when the corridor is the narrowest
 - Avoid wetlands
 - Maintain offsets from ATC towers
 - Maintain drainage patterns
 - Avoid utility conflicts
- City will obtain a license agreement with We Energies to allow for the trail to be located in the corridor
- We Energies is the corridor owner
